"I seek Your forgiveness." Dua After Leaving the Toilet is a short Masnoon Dua to recite after leaving the toilet. In this dua, we ask Allah Ta'ala for forgiveness . More Duas You May Like Dua Before Entering the Toilet Dua Before Eating Dua After Waking Up in the Morning Dua Before Drinking Milk

19. Dua Before Wudu

This dua includes the testimony of Allah’s oneness and the Prophethood of Muhammad ﷺ, followed by a supplication to be among those who repent and purify themselves.

21. Dua for Ghusl-e-Janabah

Arabic Dua

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الَّذِي أَتَطَهَّرُ بِهِ لِأَرْفَعَ الْحَدَثَ الْأَكْبَرَ

Roman English

Bismillaahil-lazee atatahhharu bihi li-arfa'al-hadathal-akbar.

English Translation

“In the name of Allah, with which I purify myself to remove the state of major ritual impurity.” Dua for Ghusl-e-Janabah is a commonly recited intention before performing Ghusl-e-Janabah. It expresses the intention to purify oneself by removing the state of major ritual impurity (Hadath al-Akbar) .

22. Dua When Wearing Clothes

English Translation

“All praise is for Allah Who has clothed me with this garment and provided it for me without any power or strength from me.”

23. Dua for Wearing New Clothes

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ الْحَمْدُ أَنْتَ كَسَوْتَنِيهِ، أَسْأَلُكَ خَيْرَهُ وَخَيْرَ مَا صُنِعَ لَهُ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّهِ وَشَرِّ مَا صُنِعَ لَهُ

Roman English

Allaahumma lakal-hamdu anta kasawtaneehi, as'aluka khairahu wa khaira maa suni'a lahu, wa a'oodhu bika min sharrihi wa sharri maa suni'a lahu.

English Translation

“O Allah, all praise is for You. You have clothed me with it. I ask You for its goodness and the goodness for which it was made, and I seek refuge in You from its evil and the evil for which it was made.” Dua for Wearing New Clothes is a beautiful Masnoon Dua to recite when wearing new clothes. This dua thanks Allah Ta'ala for providing the new garment and asks for its goodness while seeking protection from its evil.

24. Dua When Looking in the Mirror

Arabic Dua

اللَّهُمَّ كَمَا حَسَّنْتَ خَلْقِي فَحَسِّنْ خُلُقِي

Roman English

Allaahumma kamaa hassanta khalqee fa-hassin khuluqee.

English Translation

“O Allah, just as You have made my appearance beautiful, make my character beautiful as well.” Dua When Looking in the Mirror is a commonly recited Dua that asks Allah Ta'ala to bless us with beautiful character and good manners along with a beautiful appearance.

25. Dua When Entering the Home

Arabic Dua

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَلَجْنَا، وَبِسْمِ اللَّهِ خَرَجْنَا، وَعَلَى رَبِّنا تَوَكَّلْنَا

Roman English

Bismillaahi walajnaa, wa bismillaahi kharajnaa, wa 'alaa Rabbinaa tawakkalnaa.

English Translation

“In the name of Allah we enter, and in the name of Allah we leave, and upon our Lord we rely.” Dua When Entering the Home is a Masnoon Dua to recite when entering the house. This dua teaches us to begin by taking Allah Ta'ala's name and placing our trust and reliance in Him .

26. Dua When Leaving the Home

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، تَوَكَّلْتُ عَلَى اللَّهِ، لَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ

English Translation

“In the name of Allah, I place my trust in Allah. There is no power and no strength except with Allah.” Dua When Leaving the Home is a Masnoon Dua to recite when leaving the house. This dua teaches us to take Allah Ta'ala's name, place our trust in Him , and remember that all power and strength belong to Allah.

27. Dua for Blessings in the Home

اللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ لَنَا فِي بَيْتِنَا، وَأَنْزِلْ عَلَيْنَا رَحْمَتَكَ، وَارْزُقْنَا السَّكِينَةَ وَالْبَرَكَاتِ

Allahumma baarik lanaa fee baitinaa, wa anzil 'alainaa rahmataka, warzuqnas-sakeenata wal-barakah.

English Translation

“O Allah, bless our home, shower Your mercy upon us, and grant us peace and blessings.” Dua for Blessings in the Home is a dua for asking Allah Ta'ala to bless our home with barkat, peace, mercy and comfort . Read the dua in Arabic along with its Roman English transliteration and English meaning.

28. Dua of Salam When Entering the Home

Assalaamu 'Alaikum.

English Translation

“Peace be upon you.” Dua of Salam When Entering the Home is a simple Islamic greeting to say when entering the house. Saying “Assalaamu ‘Alaikum” is a beautiful Islamic etiquette that conveys peace and blessings to the people of the home.

“My Lord, let me land at a blessed landing place, and You are the best of those who provide a landing place.” Dua When Moving Into a New Home can be recited when settling into a new house. This dua asks Allah Ta'ala for a blessed place to stay and seeks His goodness and blessings in the new home.

30. Dua for Protection of the Home from Shaytan

أَعُوذُ بِكَلِمَاتِ اللَّهِ التَّامَّاتِ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ

Roman English

A'oodhu bi kalimaatillaahit-taammaati min sharri maa khalaq.

English Translation

“I seek refuge in the perfect words of Allah from the evil of what He has created.” Dua for Protection of the Home from Shaytan can be recited to seek Allah Ta'ala's protection from the evil of His creation. This powerful dua asks Allah for refuge in His perfect words and His protection from all forms of harm.

31. Dua When Eating at Home

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ

Roman English

Bismillaah.

English Translation

“In the name of Allah.”

32. Dua for Trusting Allah When Leaving Home

Arabic Dua

Allaahummaftah lee abwaaba rahmatik.

English Translation

“O Allah, open for me the doors of Your mercy.” Dua When Entering the Mosque is a Masnoon Dua to recite when entering the Masjid. In this dua, we ask Allah Ta'ala to open the doors of His mercy for us.

34. Dua When Leaving the Mosque

Arabic Dua

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ فَضْلِكَ

Roman English

Allaahumma innee as'aluka min fadlik.

English Translation

“O Allah, I ask You for Your bounty.” Dua When Leaving the Mosque is a Masnoon Dua to recite when leaving the Masjid. In this dua, we ask Allah Ta'ala for His ﷻ (bounty), grace and blessings as we leave the mosque.

35. Dua While Going to the Mosque
